- Goals

- Strategies
  - Shorten pedestrian crossing distances
  - Narrow lanes
  - Buffer pedestrians from the roadway
  - Connect sidewalks
  - Create "tunneling effect"
  - Shorten and/or eliminate protected right/left turn lanes
  - Add streetlights, landscaping, benches, and more





















48<sup>th</sup>/Skyline: Existing vs. Concept





Section A – North of W. 50<sup>th</sup> Terrace
